
Dressing Gown from squares version 1


- Our example makes a dressing gown that will fit most people. You can make slightly smaller or larger versions.
- The squares can be knitted or crocheted
- Our samples were made in double knitting on a 4mm needle or crochet hook. Do not use a yarn thicker than double knitting, in case the garment gets too heavy.




Knit or crochet a belt 6cm wide by 180-200 cm long.

Seams

You may decide to make the seams a decorative feature by using a contrasting colour, or you may decide to sew up using the same colour.

Joining

Making up the body:

Join seams A + B together and C + D together *Making up the sleeves*:

Join seams E + F together and G + H together.

Edging

You can add a crochet border (double or treble crochet) around all the edges - neck, front opening, hem, cuffs.

Details

You can add a pocket and a belt if you wish.

Smoking Jacket version 2 (shorter length)

To make a shorter smoking jacket work 3 squares (36 cm) from hem to arm hole not 6.
