2 Stitch Holders for the Sweater. 1 Stitch Holder for the Cardigan.

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

alt alternate beg beginning cont continue dec decrease(ing) foll following inc increase(ing) k knit **p** purl rem remain(ing) rep repeat rs right side st(s) stitch(es) mm millimetres in inch(es) ws wrong side cm centimetres tog together sl slip tbl through back loop kf&b knit into the front and back of the stitch.

1st Row: \*K2, P2; rep from \* to the last 2 sts, K2. 2nd Row: \*P2, K2; rep from \* to the last 2 sts, P2. The quantities of yarn are based upon average requirement and are therefore approximate.

TENSION 28 sts and 30 rows to 10cm, 4in over pattern, 32 sts and 30 rows over 2 x 2 rib. using 4mm needles, or the size required to give the correct tension.

**VERY IMPORTANT IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO** THE STATED TENSION TO **ENSURE SUCCESS.** 

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles; if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

NOTES: Instructions for the Sweater and Cardigan are given for 35½ cm, 14in; larger sizes are given in square brackets.

TIP: Highlight the size to be knitted throughout the pattern prior to knitting. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

# **SWEATER** \*\*\*BACK

Using 3.25mm Needles and thumb method. Cast on 58 [66:70:78:86:94]

1st Row (RS): \*K2, p2; rep from \* to the last 2 sts. K2.

2<sup>nd</sup> Row (WS): \*P2, k2; rep from \* to the last 2 sts, P2.

These 2 rows set 2 x 2 rib.

Cont in 2 x 2 rib until work meas

4 [4½:5:5½:6:6] cm.

1½ [1¾:2:2½: 2½] in. From the beg. Ending with a WS row.

Change to 4mm Needles.

1<sup>st</sup> Row: Knit. 2<sup>nd</sup> Row: Purl.

3<sup>rd</sup> Row: P3 [P7:K1,p8:P3:P7:P1]

\*K2, p8; rep from \* to the last

5 [9:1:5:9:3] sts.

K2,p3 [K2,p7:K1:K2,p3:K2,p7:K2,p1]. 4<sup>th</sup> Row: K3 [K7:P1,k8:K3:K7:K1]

\*P2. k8: rep from \* to the last 5 [9:1:5:9:3] sts.

P2,k3 [P2,k7:P1:P2,k3:P2,k7:P2,k1] 5<sup>th</sup> Row: K1 [P1,k4:K1,p2,k4:K1:

P1,k4:P1,k2,p2,k4]

\*P2, k2, p2, k4; rep from \* to the last 7 [1:3:7:1:5] sts.

P2,k2,p2,k1 [P1:P2,k1:P2,k2,p2,k1: P1:P2,k2,p1].

**6**<sup>th</sup> **Row:** P1 [K1,p4:P1,k2,p4:P1:

K1,p4:K1,p2,k2,p4] \*K2, p2, k2, p4; rep from \* to the last 7 [1:3:7:1:5] sts.

K2,p2,k2,p1 [K1:K2,p1:K2,p2,k2,p1: K1:K2,p2,k1].

Rep the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> rows twice more. **11<sup>th</sup> Row:** As the 3<sup>rd</sup> row.

12<sup>th</sup> Row: As the 4<sup>th</sup> row. These 12 rows set the patt into

position.

From the beg.

Cont straight in patt until work meas

10[12:14:15:16½:18] cm. 4[43/4:51/2:6:61/2:7] in.

Mark Armhole Position.\*\*\*.

Cont straight in patt as set until work meas 20 [22½:25½:28:30½:33] cm. 8 [9:10:11:12:13] in. From the beg.

Ending with a WS row.

Next Row: Cast off 18 [22:22:26:26: 30] sts. Patt 22 [22:26:26:34:34] sts, place these sts onto a stitch holder to return to later for the Back Neck rib.

Make Shoulder Button Band. Change to 3.25 mm Needles.

Working on the 18 [22:22:26:26:30] sts rem on the needle \*K2, p2; rep from \* to the last 2 rem sts, K2. Next Row: \*P2, k2; rep from \* to

the last 2 rem sts, P2.

These 2 rows set 2 x 2 rib into position.

Work 4 more rows in 2 x 2 rib.

Cast off in rib.

## **FRONT**

Work as for Back from \*\*\* to \*\*\*. Cont straight in patt as set until work meas 15½ [17:19½:21:23½: 25] cm. 6 [6<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>:7<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>:8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>:9<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>:10] in. From the beg. Ending with a WS

Shape Neck and Right Shoulder. **Next Row:** Keeping to patt as set. Patt 23 [27:28:32:34:38] sts. Place these sts onto a stitch holder to return to later for the Left neck and shoulder.

Cast off 12 [12:14:14:18:18] sts. Patt 23 [27:28:32:34:38] sts.

\*\* **Next Row:** Dec 1 st at the neck edge only on this and every foll row until 18 [22:22:26:26:30] sts rem on the needle.\*\*.

Cont straight in patt as set until work meas 20 [22½:25½:28:30½: 33] cm.

8 [9:10:11:12:13] in. From the beg. Ending with a WS row.

Cast off.

Rejoin the yarn at neck edge to the 23 [27:28:32:34:38] sts on the stitch holder for the Left neck and shoulder.

Work as for Right neck and shoulder from \*\* to \*\*. Cont straight in patt as set until

work meas 18 [20:221/2:251/2:28: 30½] cm. 7 [8:9:10:11:12] in.

Ending with a RS row

Change to 3.25 mm Needles. Make Shoulder Button Band.

Working on the 18 [22:22:26:26:30] sts rem on the needle

Next Row (WS): \*K2, p2; rep from \* to the last 2 rem sts, K2.

Next Row (RS): \*P2, k2; rep from \* to the last 2 rem sts, P2.

These 2 rows set 2 x 2 rib into position.

Next Row (Make Buttonhole): Rib to last 5 sts, cast off 2 sts, rib 2 sts. Next Row: Rib 3 sts, turn, cast on 2 sts, turn, and rib to end. Work 2 more rows in 2 x 2 rib. Cast off in rib.

## **SLEEVES** (Both the same)

Using 3.25mm Needles and thumb method. Cast on 42 [42:46:46:50:50] sts. Work 21/2 cm.(1 in) in 2 x 2 rib. Ending with a WS row.

Change to 4mm Needles.

1st Row: Knit. 2<sup>nd</sup> Row: Purl.

3<sup>rd</sup> Row: P5 [P5:P7:P7:K1,p8:

K1,p8], \*K2, p8; rep from \* to the last 7 [7:9:9:1:1] sts; K2,p5 [K2,p5:K2,p7:

K2,p7:K1:K1].

**4**<sup>th</sup> **Row:** K5 [K5:K7:K7:P1,k8:P1,k8] \*P2, k8; rep from \* to the last 7 [7:9: 9:1:1] sts; P2,k5 [P2,k5:P2,k7: P2,k7:P1:P1].

5<sup>th</sup> Row (Increase row): K1,kf&b,k1 [K1,kf&b,k1:P1,kf&b,k3:P1,kf&b,k3: K1,pf&b,p1,k4: K1,pf&b,p1,k4] \*P2, k2, p2, k4; rep from \* to the last 9 [9:11:11:3:3] sts; P2,k2,p2,k1,kf&b,k1

[P2,k2,p2,k1,kf&b,k1:P2,k2,p2,k3, kf&b,p1: P2,k2,p2,k3,kf&b,p1:P1,

pf&b,p1:P1,pf&b,k1]

These 5 rows place the 12 row patt into position. Continue in patt as set. At the same time keeping to patt and incorporating patt into increase rows. Inc 1 st at each end of the next and every foll 4<sup>th</sup> [2<sup>nd</sup>:4<sup>th</sup>:2<sup>nd</sup>:2<sup>nd</sup>:2<sup>nd</sup>] row until 52 [62:62:72:82:82] sts on the needle. Cont straight in patt as set until work meas 11½ [12½:15: 18:20:23] cm. 4½[5:6:7:8:9] in. Ending with a WS row. Cast off.

#### **NECKBAND**

Join Right Shoulder seam. With RS of work facing. Using 3.25mm Needles. Pick up and knit 14 [16:17: 19:19:21] sts evenly from the left front neck edge.12 [12:14:14:18:18] sts from the centre front and 14 [16: 17:19:19:21] sts evenly from the right front neck edge. Pick up the 22 [22: 26:26:34:34] sts from the stitch holder for the Back neck and 6 sts from the button band. 68 [72:80:84: 96:100] sts on the needle.

1st Row (WS): \*K2, p2; rep from \* to the end of the row. Rep this row once more.

Next Row (Make Buttonhole): Rib to the last 5 sts. Cast off 2 sts. Rib 2. Next Row: Rib 3 sts. turn. cast on 2 sts. turn. rib to the end of the row. Work 2 more rows in rib. Cast off in rib.

# TO MAKE UP

Join sleeves to main body. Join underarm sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

Finish off all loose ends securely. See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

# CARDIGAN BACK

Work as for Sweater back from \*\*\* to \*\*\*.

Cont straight in patt until work meas 20 [22½:25½:28:30½:33] cm. 8 [9:10:11:12:13] in. From the beg. Ending with a WS row. Shape Neck and Shoulders. Next Row: Cast off 18 [22:22:26: 26:301 sts. Patt the central 22 [22:26:26:34:34] sts and place onto a stitch holder to return to later for the Back Neck rib. Cast off the rem 18 [22:22:26:26:30] sts.

# LEFT FRONT

Using 3.25mm Needles and thumb method. Cast on 26 [28:32:36:38:42] sts. \*\* 1<sup>'st</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> sizes. 1st Row (RS): \*K2, p2; rep from \* to the last 2 sts. K2.

2<sup>nd</sup> Row (WS): \*P2, k2; rep from \* to the last 2 sts. P2.

2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> sizes.

1st Row (RS): \*K2, p2; rep from \* to the end of the row.

2<sup>nd</sup> Row (WS): Rep the 1<sup>st</sup> row. These 2 rows set 2 x 2 rib. Cont in 2 x 2 rib until work meas 4 [4½:5:5½:6:6] cm.

1½ [1¾:2:2½: 2½] in. From the beg.

Ending with a WS row. \*\*.

Change to 4mm Needles.

1<sup>st</sup> Row: Knit. 2<sup>nd</sup> Row: Purl.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Row:** P3 [P7:K1,p8:P3:P7: P1], \*K2, p8; rep from \* to the last 3 [1:3:3:1:1] sts,

K2,p1 [K1:K2,p1:K2,p1:K1:K1].

**4**<sup>th</sup> **Row:** K1 [P1,k8:K1:K1:P1,k8: P1,k8], \*P2, k8; rep from \* to the last 5 [9:1:5:9:3] sts.

P2,k3 [P2,k7:P1:P2,k3:P2,k7: P2,k1].

**5**<sup>th</sup> **Row:** K1 [P1,k4:K1,p2,k4:K1: P1,k4:P1,k2,p2,k4]

\*P2, k2, p2, k4; rep from \* to the last 5 [3:5:5:3:3] sts.

P2,k2,p1 [P2,k1:P2,k2,p1: P2,k2,p1:P2,k1:P2,k1].

6<sup>th</sup> Row: K1,p2,k2,p4

[P1,k2,p4:K1,p2,k2,p4:K1,p2,k2,p 4:P1,k2,p4:P1,k2,p4], \*K2, p2, k2, p4; rep from \* to the last 7 [1:3:7:1:5] sts,

K2,p2,k2,p1 [K1:K2,p1: K2,p2,k2,p1:K1:K2,p2,k1]. Rep the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> rows twice more.

11<sup>th</sup> Row: As the 3<sup>rd</sup> row. 12<sup>th</sup> Row: As the 4<sup>th</sup> row.

These 12 rows set the patt into position.

Cont straight in patt until work meas 7  $[8\frac{1}{2}:10:11\frac{1}{2}:13:14\frac{1}{2}]$  cm.  $2\frac{3}{4}[3\frac{1}{4}:4:4\frac{1}{2}:5\frac{1}{4}:5\frac{3}{4}]$  in. From the beg. Ending with a RS row.

Shape Neck.

Keeping to patt as set and incorporating patt into decrease rows. Dec 1 st at the beg of the next and every foll 4<sup>th</sup> row at the neck edge only.

**At the same time** when work meas 10[12:14:15:16½:18] cm. 4[4¾:5½: 6:6½:7] in. From the beg.

#### Mark Armhole position.

Cont in patt as set and to dec at neck edge until 18 [22:22:26:26:30] sts rem on the needle. Cont straight in patt until work meas 20[22½:25½:28:30½:33] cm. 8[9:10:11:12:13] in. From the beg. Ending with a WS row. Cast off.

## RIGHT FRONT

Using 3.25mm Needles and thumb method. Cast on 26 [28:32:36:38:42] sts.
Work as for Left Front from \*\* to \*\*.
Change to 4mm Needles.

1<sup>st</sup> Row: Knit. 2<sup>nd</sup> Row: Purl.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Row:** P1 [K1,p8:P1:P1:K1,p8: K1,p8], \*K2, p8; rep from \* to the last 5 [9:1:5:9:3] sts.

K2,p3 [K2,p7:K1:K2,p3:K2,p7:

K2,p1].

**4**<sup>th</sup> **Row:** K3 [K7:P1,k8:K3:K7:K1] \*P2, k8; rep from \* to the last 3 [1:3:3:1:1] sts,

P2,k1 [P1:P2,k1:P2,k1:P1:P1].

**5**<sup>th</sup> **Row:** P1,k2 [K1:P1,k2:P1,k2: K1:K1] \*P2,k4,p2,k2; rep from \* to the last 3 [7:9:3:7:1] sts.

P2,k1 [P2,k4,p1:P2,k4,p2,k1:P2,k1:

P2,k4,p1:P1].

**6<sup>th</sup> Row:** P1 [K1,p4:P1,k2,p4:P1: K1,p4:K1,p2,k2,p4]. \*K2,p2,k2,p4; rep from \* to the last 5 [3:5:5:3:3] sts. K2,p2,k1 [K2,p1:K2,p2,k1: K2,p2,k1:K2,p1]. Rep the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> rows twice

Rep the 5" and 6" rows twice more.

**11<sup>th</sup> Row:** As the 3<sup>rd</sup> row. **12<sup>th</sup> Row:** As the 4<sup>th</sup> row.

These 12 rows set the patt into position.

Cont straight in patt until work meas 7 [8½:10:11½:13:14½] cm. 2¾ [3¼:4:4½:5½:5¾:5¾] in. From the beg. Ending with a WS row.

Shape Neck.

Keeping to patt as set and incorporating patt into decrease rows. Dec 1 st at the beg of the next and every foll 4<sup>th</sup> row at the neck edge only.

**At the same time** when work meas 10 [12:14:15:16½:18] cm. 4 [4¾:5½: 6:6½:7] in. From the beg.

Mark Armhole position. Cont in patt as set and to dec at neck edge until 18 [22:22:26:26:30] sts rem on the needle. Cont straight in patt until work meas

20[22½:25½:28:30½:33] cm. 8[9:10:11:12:13] in. From the beg. Ending with a WS row. Cast off.

# **SLEEVES** (Both the same)

Work as for Sweater Sleeves.

## **NECKBAND**

Join shoulder seams. With RS of work facing.

Using 3.25 mm Needles and commencing at the front rib edge, pick up and knit 60 [68:74:82:90:96] sts from the front edge, 22 [22:26:26: 34:34] sts from the Back neck and 60 [68:74:82:90:96] sts from the front edge. 142 [158:174:190:214:226] sts.

Next Row: Knit.

1<sup>st</sup> Row: \*K2, p2; rep from \* to the last 2 sts, K2.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Row:** \*P2, k2; rep from \* to the last 2 sts, P2.

These 2 rows set 2 x 2 rib.

Work one more row in 2 x 2 rib.

Make Buttonholes.

**Next Row:** Rib 5, cast off 2 sts, \*Rib 12 [16:20:12:14:16] sts, cast off 2 sts.\*

4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Sizes Only: Rep from \* to \* once more.

All Sizes: Rib to end.

**Next Row:** Rib to last 20 [22:28:34: 38:42] sts, turn, cast on 2 sts, \*Rib 13 [17:21:\*13:15:17] sts, turn, cast on 2 sts.\*

4<sup>th</sup>,5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Sizes Only: Rep from \* to \* once more.

**All Sizes:** Rib to end. Work 3 more rows in 2 x 2 rib.

Cast off in rib.

# Stylecraft

discover, create and enjoy

TO MAKE UP

Matching edges at underarm and centre of sleeve head cast off edge to shoulder seam.

Sew sleeves into armholes.
Sew buttons into position.
Finish off all loose ends securely. See ball band for pressing and care instructions.

### **HAT**

**Using 3.25mm Needles** and thumb method. Cast on 72 [80:88:96:104:104] sts.

1<sup>st</sup> Row (RS): \*K2, p2; rep from \* to the end of the row.

This row sets 2 x 2 rib.

Cont straight in 2 x 2 rib until work meas 14 [15:16½:17½:19:20] cm.  $5\frac{1}{2}$  [6:6½:7:7½:8] in. From the beg. Ending with a WS row.

**1<sup>st</sup> Row:** \*K2, p2tog; rep from \* to the end of the row.

54 [60:66:72:78] sts

2<sup>nd</sup> Row: \*K1, p2, k1, p2; rep from \* to the end of the row.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Row:** \*K2tog, p1; rep from \* to the end of the row. 36 [40:44:48: 52:52] sts.

4<sup>th</sup> Row: \*K1, P1; rep from \* to the end of the row.

**5**<sup>th</sup> **Row:** \*K2tog; rep from \* to the end of the row. 18 [20:22:24:26:26] sts.

6<sup>th</sup> Row: Purl.

**7**<sup>th</sup> **Row:** \*K2tog; rep from \* to the end of the row. 9 [10:11:12:13:13] sts. **8**<sup>th</sup> **Row:** \*P2tog; rep from \* to the last

1 [0:1:0:1:1] sts.
5 [5:6:6:7:7] sts rem on the needle.

5 [5:6:6:7:7] sts rem on the needle. Break off yarn and thread tail through rem sts.

Make Tassel: Cut a piece of cardboard 12.5cm (5in) wide. Wind yarn around the width of the cardboard 22 times. Break yarn, leaving a long end, and thread the end through a yarn needle. Slip the needle under all the loops and tie tightly. Slip the yarn away from the cardboard and wind the yarn several times around the loops approx 2cm (¾in) below fold. Draw needle through top and secure tassel to top of hat. Cut strands at opposite end of tassel and trim evenly.

Join back seam.
Finish off all loose ends securely.
