Ladies' and girls hat and scarf Featured in Prima December 2009





SIZE

To fit 4-6(7-9:10-12) years and women **Hats** - to fit an average size child's/adult head for the size indicated **Scarves** - 17 x 146cm; 18 x 156cm; 20 x 166cm; 20 x 176cm

MATERIALS

All items are worked in K004 Sublime extra fine merino wool dk

Adult's Plain Hat - Two 50g balls in Myrtle 6 (A)

Girl's Striped Hat - One 50g ball in each of Taffeta 63 (A), Passion 173 (B) and Waterleaf 19 (C).

Red Striped Scarf - 3(3:4:4) 50g balls in

Red Hot 167 (A) and one 50g ball in each of Waterleaf 19 (B), Passion 173 (C) and Taffeta 63 (D)

Pink Striped Scarf - 3(3:4:4) 50g balls in Passion 173 (A) and one 50g ball in each of Taffeta 63 (B), Sloeberry 67 (C) and Myrtle 66 (D)

Pair of 4mm knitting needles

TENSIONS

Hat - 20 sts and 28 rows to 10cm over 4x4 rib when slightly stretched using 4mm needles.

Scarf - 22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm over st-st using 4mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm centimetres; cont continue; k knit; p purl; rep repeat; RS right side; st(s) stitch(es); st-st stocking stitch; tog together; WS wrong side.

HAT STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work 10 rows in A, 10 rows in B, 10 rows in C.

HATS

With 4mm needles and A, cast on 84(92:100:108) sts. **1st row** (RS) K4, [p4, k4] to end. **2nd row** P4, [k4, p4] to end. These 2 rows **form** 4x4 rib and are repeated. Cont in rib in A only for plain hat and in stripe sequence for striped hat, until hat measures 22(23:24:24)cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape crown

1st row K4, * [p2tog] twice, k4; rep from * to end. 64(70:76:82) sts. **2nd row** P4, [k2, p4] to end. **3rd row** K1, k2tog, k1, [p2tog, k1, k2tog, k1] to end. 43(47:51:55) sts. **4th row** P3, [k1, p3] to end. **5th row** K1, [k2tog] 21(23:25:27) times. 22(24:26:28) sts. **6th row** P1, [p3tog] 7(7:8:9) times, p0(2:1:0). 8(10:10:10) sts. Break yarn, thread though remaining sts, pull up, fasten off and join back seam.

SCARVES

With 4mm needles and A, cast on 42(46:50:50) sts. Work in rib as follows: **1st row** (RS) [K1, p1] 3 times, [k2, p2] to

last 8 sts, k2, [p1, k1] 3 times. **2nd row** [P1, k1] 3 times, p2, [k2, p2] to last 6 sts, [k1, p1] 3 times. These 2 rows form rib and are repeated 3 times more. Now work in main patt as follows: 1st row [K1, p1] 3 times, k to last 6 sts, [p1, k1] 3 times. 2nd row [P1, k1] 3 times, p to last 6 sts, [k1, p1] 3 times. These 2 rows form the main patt and are repeated 3 times more. Keeping main patt correct work as follows: 2 rows in B, 4 rows in C, 4 rows in D, 4 rows in C, 4 rows in D, 4 rows in C, 4 rows in D, 4 rows in C and 2 rows in B. With A, work a further 48(53:58:63) cm, ending with a WS row. [Work 4 rows in B, 4 rows in A] 4 times then 4 rows in B. With A, work a further 48(53:58:63) cm, ending with a WS row. Work 2 rows in B, 4 rows in C, 4 rows in D, 4 rows in C, 4 rows in D, 4 rows in C, 4 rows in D, 4 rows in C and 2 rows in B. With A, work 8 rows in main patt. Beg with 1st row of rib patt work 8 rows. Cast off in rib.
