## MATERIALS

Jacket with Hood
F075 Snuggly DK shade 265
Jacket with Collar
F075 Snuggly DK shade 268

| 2 | 2 | 3 | 4 | 4 | 5 | 50 g balls |

Also suitable for Sirdar Supersoft DK, Snuggly Baby Bamboo DK and Tiny Tots DK. Amounts may vary.

The yarn amounts are based on average requirements when specified tension and yarn is used.
You will also need 1 Pair of 4 mm (UK8 - USA6) Knitting Needles, 1 Pair of $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ (UK10 - USA3) Knitting Needles and Stitch Holder for Jacket with Hood. 5 [5:5:6:6:6] Buttons.


## TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm , (4in) over stocking stitch on 4 mm needles or the size required to give correct tension. Check your tension - if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.
IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

## ABBREVIATIONS

alt alternate, beg beginning, $\mathbf{c m}$ centimetres, cont continue, dec decrease(ing), DK double knitting, foll following, $\mathbf{g}$ grammes, in inch(es), inc increase(ing), $\mathbf{k}$ knit, mm millimetres, $\mathbf{0}$ no stitches, times or rows, $\mathbf{p}$ purl, patt pattern, psso pass slipped stitch over, rem remain(ing), rep repeat, rs right side, s1 slip 1 stitch knitways, st(s) stitch(es), tbl through back of loop, tog together, ws wrong side, yfwd yarn forward, yon yarn over needle, yrn yarn round needle.

## JACKET WITH HOOD BACK

Using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles and thumb method cast on 58 [66:70:78:82:90] sts.
1st Row. * K2, p2, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.
2nd Row. P2, * k2, p2, rep from * to end. These 2 rows will now be referred to as 2x2 rib.
Work 5 [5:5:7:7:7] rows more in $2 \times 2$ rib.
Next Row. P4 [5:6:2:4:5], p2tog, (p5 [4:6: 6:6:5], p2tog) 7 [9:7:9:9:11] times, p3 [5:6: 2:4:6]. 50 [56:62:68:72:78] sts.
Change to 4 mm needles and proceed as follows:-
1st Row. Knit.
2nd Row. Purl.
These 2 rows will now be referred to as st-st (stocking stitch).
Working in st-st (throughout) cont until back measures 12 [15:18:23:26:31]cm,
(43/4 [6:7:9:101/4:12]in), ending with a ws row.

## Shape Raglan

Cast off 3 [3:3:4:4:4] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 44 [50:56:60:64:70] sts.

## For 3rd, 4th and 6th sizes only

Next Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. [54:58:68] sts.
Next Row. P1, p2tog, purl to last 3 sts, p2togtbl, p1. [52:56:66] sts. Rep last 2 rows [0:1:1] times more. [52:52:62] sts.

## For all 6 sizes

1st Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 3
sts, k2tog, k1. 42 [48:50:50:62:60] sts.
2nd Row. Purl.
1st and 2 nd rows set raglan shapings.
Work 24 [28:28:28:36:34] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in next and every foll alt row. 18 [20:22:22:26:26] sts. ** Leave rem 18 [20:22:22:26:26] sts on a stitch holder.

## LEFT FRONT

Using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles and thumb method cast on 27 [ $31: 35: 35: 39: 43$ ] sts.
1st Row. * K2, p2, rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, p1.
2nd Row. K1, p2, * k2, p2, rep from * to end.
1st and 2 nd rows set rib.
Work 5 [5:5:7:7:7] rows more in rib.
Next Row. P4 [2:1:4:4:3], p2tog, (p4 [3:3:
6:4:4], p2tog) 3 [5:6:3:5:6] times, p3 [2:2:
5:3:2]. 23 [25:28:31:33:36] sts.
Change to 4 mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until left front measures 12 [15:18:23:26:31]cm,
(43/4 [6:7:9:101/4:12]in), ending with a ws row.

## Shape Raglan

Next Row. Cast off 3 [3:3:4:4:4] sts, knit to end. 20 [22:25:27:29:32] sts.
Next Row. Purl.

For 3rd, 4th and 6th sizes only
Next Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to end.
[24:26:31] sts.
Next Row. Purl to last 3 sts, p2togtbl, p1. [23:25:30] sts.
Rep last 2 rows [0:1:1] times more.
[23:23:28] sts.

For all 6 sizes
1st Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to end. 19 [21:22:22:28:27] sts.
2nd Row. Purl.
1 st and 2 nd rows set raglan shaping.
Work 21 [25:25:23:31:29] rows dec 1 st at raglan edge as before in next and every foll alt row. 8 [8:9:10:12:12] sts.

Shape Neck
Next Row. Cast off 4 [4:5:4:5:5] sts, purl to end. 4 [4:4:6:7:7] sts.

## For 1st, 2nd and 3rd sizes only

Next Row. K1, s1, k2tog, psso. 2 sts.

For 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only
Next Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, k[1:2:2], k2tog. [4:5:5] sts.
Next Row. P2tog, p[2:3:3]. [3:4:4] sts.
Next Row. K1, s1, k[1:0:0], (k2tog) [0:1:1]
times, psso. 2 sts.

## For all 6 sizes

Next Row. P2tog. Fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT

Using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles and thumb method cast on 27 [31:35:35:39:43] sts.
1st Row. P1, k2, * p2, k2, rep from * to end.
2nd Row. * P2, k2, rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1.
1st and 2nd rows set rib.
Work 5 [5:5:7:7:7] rows more in rib.
Next Row. P3 [2:2:5:3:2], p2tog, (p4 [3:3: 6:4:4], p2tog) 3 [5:6:3:5:6] times, p4 [2:1: 4:4:3]. 23 [25:28:31:33:36] sts.
Change to 4 mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until right front measures 12 [15:18:23:26:31]cm, (43/4 [6:7:9:101/4:12]in), ending with a rs row.

## Shape Raglan

Next Row. Cast off 3 [3:3:4:4:4] sts, purl to end. 20 [22:25:27:29:32] sts.

For 3rd, 4th and 6th sizes only
Next Row. Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. [24:26:31] sts.

Next Row. P1, p2tog, purl to end. [23:25:30] sts.
Rep last 2 rows [0:1:1] times more.
[23:23:28] sts.

## For all 6 sizes

1st Row. Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. 19 [21:22:22:28:27] sts.
2nd Row. Purl.
1st and 2 nd rows set raglan shaping.
Work 20 [24:24:22:30:28] rows dec 1 st at raglan edge as before in next and every foll alt row. 9 [9:10:11:13:13] sts.

## Shape Neck

Next Row. Cast off 4 [4:5:4:5:5] sts, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. 4 [4:4:6:7:7] sts.
Next Row. Purl.
For 1st, 2nd and 3rd sizes only
Next Row. S1, k2tog, psso, k1. 2 sts.
For 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only
Next Row. K2tog, k[1:2:2], k2tog, k1. [4:5:5] sts.
Next Row. P[2:3:3], p2tog. [3:4:4] sts.
Next Row. (K2tog) [1:0:0] times, (k3tog)
[0:1:1] times, k1. 2 sts.

## For all 6 sizes

Next Row. P2tog. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles and thumb method cast on 42 [42:46:46:50:54] sts, work 7 [7:7:9:9:9] rows in $2 \times 2$ rib.
Next Row. P3 [3:1:2:4:2], p2tog, (p5 [5:4: 6:6:5], p2tog) 5 [5:7:5:5:7] times, p2 [2:1: 2:4:1]. 36 [36:38:40:44:46] sts.
Change to 4 mm needles and working in st-st (throughout) inc 1 st at each end of 13th [5th:5th:5th:5th:5th] and every foll 12th [8th:8th:8th:8th:8th] row to 40 [44:48:48:48:50] sts.

For 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only
Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 10th row to [52:58:62] sts.

## For all 6 sizes

Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 15 [17:20:24:29:33]cm, (6 [61/2: 8:91/2:111/2:13]in), or length required, ending with a ws row.

## Shape Raglan

Cast off 3 [3:3:4:4:4] sts at beg of next 2
rows. 34 [38:42:44:50:54] sts.

Proceed as follows:-
1st Row. K1, s1, k1, psso, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. 32 [36:40:42:48:52] sts. 2nd Row. Purl.
1st and 2nd rows set raglan shapings.
For 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only
Work 6 [6:6:6:2] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in 3rd [3rd:3rd:3rd:0] row. 30 [34:38:40:48] sts.

## For all 6 sizes

Work 18 [22:24:26:34:38] rows dec 1 st at each end as before in next and every foll alt row. 12 [12:14:14:14:14] sts.
Cast off rem 12 [12:14:14:14:14] sts.

## RIGHT FRONT BORDER

With rs facing, using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles pick up and knit 6 [6:6:8:8:8] sts evenly along rib and 48 [60:72:78:90:106] sts evenly along front edge. 54 [66:78:86:98:114] sts. Starting with 2 nd row of $2 \times 2$ rib work 4 rows in rib.

## For a Girl

For 1st and 4th sizes only
Next Row. Rib 2, yon, rib2tog,
(rib 10 [14], yon, rib2tog) 4 [5] times, rib 2.

## For 2nd size only

Next Row. Rib 2, (yon, rib2tog, rib 13) twice, (yrn, rib2tog, rib 13) twice, yon, rib2tog, rib 2.

## For 3rd size only

Next Row. Rib 2, yon, rib2tog, (rib 16, yrn, rib2tog, rib 16, yon, rib2tog) twice, rib 2.

## For 5th size only

Next Row. Rib 3, (yrn, rib2tog, rib 16, yon, rib2tog, rib 16) twice, yrn, rib2tog, rib 16, yon, rib2tog, rib 3.

## For 6th size only

Next Row. Rib 3, (yrn, rib2tog, rib 19)
twice, (yon, rib2tog, rib 19) twice, yrn, rib2tog, rib 19, yrn, rib2tog, rib 4.

## For all 6 sizes

Work 4 rows more in rib.
Cast off in rib.

## For a Boy

Work 5 rows more in rib.

## LEFT FRONT BORDER

With rs facing, using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles pick up and knit 48 [60:72:78:90:106] sts evenly along front edge and 6 [6:6:8:8:8] sts evenly along rib.
54 [66:78:86:98:114] sts.
Starting with 2 nd row of $2 \times 2$ rib work 4 rows in rib.

## For a Girl

Work 5 rows more in rib.
Cast off in rib.
For a Boy
For 1st and 4th sizes only
Next Row. Rib 2, rib2tog, yrn, (rib 10 [14], rib2tog, yrn) 4 [5] times, rib 2.

## For 2nd size only

Next Row. Rib 2, rib2tog, yrn, rib 13, rib2tog, yfwd, rib 13, rib2tog, yon, rib 13, rib2tog, yrn, rib 13, rib2tog, yrn rib 2.

## For 3rd size only

Next Row. Rib 2, rib2tog, yrn, (rib 16, rib2tog, yon, rib 16, rib2tog, yrn) twice, rib 2.

## For 5th size only

Next Row. Rib 3, (rib2tog, yrn, rib 16, rib2tog, yfwd, rib 16) twice, rib2tog, yrn, rib 16, rib2tog, yfwd, rib 3.

## For 6th size only

Next Row. Rib 4, rib2tog, yon, rib 19, rib2tog, yfwd, rib 19, (rib2tog, yrn, rib 19) twice, rib2tog, yon, rib 19, rib2tog, yfwd, rib 3.

## For all 6 sizes

Work 4 rows more in rib.
Cast off in rib.

## HOOD

Join raglan seams. Using 4 mm needles cast on 23 [23:23:26:26:26] sts, with rs facing using same needle and yarn work across 18 [20:22:22:26:26] sts left on stitch holder at back of neck as follows:k3 [4:4:4:3:3], pick up loop between last and next st and work into back of this loop (this will now be referred to as $\mathbf{m 1}$ ), (k4 [4:3:3:4:4], m1) 3 [3:5:5:5:5] times, k3 [4:3:3:3:3], cast on 23 [23:23:26:26:26] sts. 68 [70:74:80:84:84] sts.
Next Row. Purl.

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until hood measures 15 [17:18:19:20:21]cm, (6 [61/2:7:7 $71 / 2: 8: 81 / 4]$ in), ending with a ws row.

## Shape Top

Next Row. Cast off 23 [23:25:27:28:28] sts, k21 [23:23:25:27:27], cast off 23 [23:25:27:28:28] sts. 22 [24:24:26:28:28] sts.
With ws facing, rejoin yarn to rem 22 [24:24:26:28:28] sts and purl to end. Cont without shaping until hood measures 10 [10:11:12:13:13]cm, (4 [4: 41/4:43/4:51/4:51/4]in) from cast off sts, ending with a ws row.
Cast off.
Join side edges at top of hood to
23 [23:25:27:28:28] cast off sts.

## HOOD BORDER

With rs facing, using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles pick up and knit 39 [44:46:49:52:54] sts evenly along right side of hood, 22 [24:24:26:
28:28] sts from top of hood and
39 [44:46:49:52:54] sts evenly along left side of hood.
100 [112:116:124:132:136] sts.
1st Row. K1, * p2, k2, rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1.
2nd Row. P1, k2, * p2, k2, rep from * to last st, p1.
1st and 2nd rows set rib.
Work 5 [5:5:7:7:7] rows more in rib. Cast off in rib.

## TO MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams. Placing ends of hood border halfway across front borders, sew hood evenly in position across sleeve tops and around neck edge. Sew on buttons. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

## JACKET WITH COLLAR BACK

Work as given for Jacket with Hood to **. Cast off rem 18 [20:22:22:26:26] sts.

## LEFT FRONT

Work as given for Left Front of Jacket with Hood.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work as given for Right Front of Jacket with Hood.

SLEEVES (Both alike)
Work as given for Sleeves of Jacket with Hood.

## RIGHT FRONT BORDER

Work as given for Right Front Border of Jacket with Hood.

## LEFT FRONT BORDER

Work as given for Left Front Border of Jacket with Hood.

## COLLAR

Join raglan seams. With rs facing, using $31 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles and starting halfway across top of right front border, pick up and knit 9 [10:9:11:12:13] sts evenly along right side of neck, 12 [14:14:14: 14:14] sts from 12 [12:14:14:14:14] cast off sts at top of right sleeve, 21 [23:26:25: 29:29] sts from 18 [20:22:22:26:26] cast off sts at back of neck, 12 [14:14:14: 14:14] sts from 12 [12:14:14:14:14] cast off sts at top of left sleeve, 9 [10:9:11: 13:13] sts evenly along left side of neck, ending halfway across top of left front border. 63 [71:72:75:83:83] sts.
1st Row. K2, (p2, k2) 5 [6:5:5:6:6] times, (p1, k2) 7 [7:10:11:11:11] times, (p2, k2) 5 [6:5:5:6:6] times.
2nd Row. (P2, k2) 5 [6:5:5:6:6] times, (p2, k1) 7 [7:10:11:11:11] times, (p2, k2) 5 [6:5: 5:6:6] times, p2.
3rd Row. As 1st row.
4th Row. (P2, k2) 5 [6:5:5:6:6] times, (p2, inc in next st) 7 [7:10:11:11:11] times, (p2, k2) 5 [6:5:5:6:6] times, p2.
70 [78:82:86:94:94] sts.
5th Row. K2, * p2, k2 rep from * to end.
6th Row. * P2, k2, rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.
Rep 5th and 6th rows until collar measures 7 [7:8:8:9:9]cm, (23/4 [23/4:3:3: $31 / 2: 31 / 2]$ in), ending with 5 th row.
Next Row. (P2, k2) 4 [5:4:4:5:5] times,
(p2, inc in next st, k1) 9 [9:12:13:13:13] times, (p2, k2) 4 [5:4:4:5:5] times, p2. 79 [87:94:99:107:107] sts.
Cast off in patt.

## TO MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
