

Twisted rib winter scarf

Designed by Knit for Peace

There are six patterns to choose from, all worked in double knitting wool on 4mm needles. Each takes about 6 x 50g balls of yarn, although the cable pattern may take a little more. This should make a scarf of 1.5 to 2 metres. Of course if you would like the scarf to be longer then add an extra 50g ball. A matching hat and gloves will also need more wool. You can get the amounts for these from patterns we have in our collection. For Design 6 you will need a cable needle.

You can add fringes, bobbles or tassels of all sorts to the ends of the scarf if you wish or leave them plain. Happy knitting!

Method



Cast on 68 stitches.

Work in K1, P1 rib for each row, making sure that you work into the back of each stich on every row. Continue until the scarf is the length you would like it to be. Cast off and darn in the loose ends.
