

Designed by Knit for Peace



Materials:

100g double knitting yarn and 4mm needles. You will also need a needle for sewing up the side and sleeve seams.

Tension:

21stitches and 44 rows over garter stitch (knit each row) using 4mm needles.

Abbreviations for this design:

beg - beginning; k - knit; sts - stitches;

Method

This jumper is knitted all in one piece.

Cast on 44 sts loosely with 4mm needles and k 60 rows.

Cast on 30 sts loosely at the beg of the next 2 rows. These 104 sts will form the sleeves.

K a further 26 rows.

Next row: K 36, cast off 32 sts loosely for the neck, k 35. Next row: K 36, cast on 32 sts loosely for the neck, k 36.

Work another 26 rows on these 104 sts.

Next row: Cast off 30, k to end. Next row: Cast off 30, k to end.

Work another 60 rows on these 44 sts. Cast off loosely.

To make up the jumper, sew the side and sleeve seams on each side.

This is just the first in a number of simple jumpers. Watch this space for more sizes and variations on the stitch used!
